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Defendants CBIZ, Inc., CBIZ MHM, LLC, Mayer Hoffman McCann, P.C., Charles A. and Eileen M. McLane, and Joel B. and Donna L. Kramer ("Defendants") hereby join in Greenberg Traurig LLP's Motion for Substitution, Joinder or Ratification of Real Parties in Interest. ECF No. 81. As set forth in that Motion, the real parties in interest in this litigation are eighteen individual investors (the "VR Investors") who created "Victims Recovery LLC" ("VR") as a "temporary conduit for the collection for the eighteen individual VR Investors." ECF No. 81, at 2. The assignment of the VR Investors' interests to VR was done simply for convenience and was not made with consideration, making it invalid.

Further, without the joinder of the VR Investors as parties, Defendants face a significant risk of prejudice. The VR Investors may attempt to resist Defendants' rightful access to full party discovery from them. And there is no assurance that the outcome of this proceeding will have its appropriate res judicata effect on the VR Investors' claims.

For these reasons, and for those reasons set forth more fully in Greenberg Traurig LLP's Motion for Substitution, Joinder or Ratification of Real Parties in Interest, Defendants respectfully request that the Court order that the VR Investors be substituted for "Victims Recovery LLC" as the plaintiffs in this matter. Alternatively, the VR Investors should be joined as additional plaintiffs or ordered to submit ratifications that they will be bound by the result of this case.
